 Make your home shine for picture day!

1. Exterior

- ☐ Mow lawn, trim hedges, remove weeds
 - ☐ Sweep walkways, driveway, porch
 - ☐ Wash windows, doors, siding if needed
 - ☐ Remove cars, boats, clutter from driveway/yard
 - ☐ Hide trash and recycling bins
 - ☐ Add fresh potted plants or flowers
 - ☐ Ensure outdoor lights work

2. Entry & Living Areas

- ☐ Declutter surfaces (tables, counters, shelves)
 - ☐ Remove personal photos & keepsakes
 - ☐ Arrange furniture to maximize space & flow
 - ☐ Straighten pillows, rugs, curtains
 - ☐ Dust surfaces & clean floors
 - ☐ Hide cords and remotes
 - ☐ Open curtains/blinds for natural light
 - ☐ Turn on all lights for consistent brightness

3. Kitchen

- ☐ Clear countertops (minimal décor only)
 - ☐ Clean appliances (inside & out if visible)
 - ☐ Remove magnets, papers, personal items from fridge
 - ☐ Organize pantry/cabinets if visible
 - ☐ Wipe sinks & faucets
 - ☐ Add small decorative touches (fruit bowl, flowers)

4. Bathrooms

- ☐ Clear countertops of personal items
 - ☐ Clean mirrors, sinks, tubs, showers, toilets
 - ☐ Hang fresh towels that match décor
 - ☐ Use clean, neutral rugs
 - ☐ Add minimal décor (plant, candle, soap dispenser)

5. Bedrooms

- ☐ Make beds neatly with clean bedding
 - ☐ Declutter surfaces (nightstands, dressers)
 - ☐ Remove personal items
 - ☐ Organize closets neatly
 - ☐ Open curtains/blinds for natural light

6. Miscellaneous

- ☐ Remove pets (or keep out of shots)

- ☐ Hide pet items (beds, litter boxes, toys)
 - ☐ Hide trash bins & cleaning supplies
 - ☐ Keep hallways/stairs clear
 - ☐ Check for cobwebs, fingerprints, dust
 - ☐ Adjust thermostat to a comfortable temperature
 - ☐ Turn off ceiling fans
 - ☐ Hide cables and wires

7. Optional “WOW” Touches

- ☐ Add fresh flowers or greenery
 - ☐ Light a scented candle before showings
 - ☐ Touch up chipped paint or scuffs
 - ☐ Replace burnt-out light bulbs
